

The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) has launched a new outreach program regarding GST rebate implications for organizations and is hosting educational sessions catered to different non-profit organizations (NPOs). The sessions will be informal and questions will be welcome throughout the presentation.

This outreach program will inform organizations in the non-profit/charitable and education sector regarding their obligations and requirements for GST/HST purposes. Many organizations incur significant expenses and have various income streams. Many complex arrangements occur, including government funding, sponsorships and P3's, creating challenges in interpreting how the GST applies. There are unique GST rules for NPOs that impact on whether they should be charging GST or being able to claim back the GST on their expenditures. This seminar would educate the NPO sector on the rules that apply to them and highlight these common issues in order to minimize the burden of a large assessment. Furthermore, many organizations may not be aware of their entitlements to certain rebates which may improve their cash flows. The session will be customized pertaining to the audience.
